¹ Note from the Chair regarding the work schedule for the meeting

In order to ensure there is appropriate time available for discussion of the text in plenary and for the more intensive and informal working mode required to resolve issues on which there are differences of view, the Chair suggests that the afternoons of Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday be allocated as times potentially available for a smaller working group (see Chair's letter of 30 August). The work schedule for Thursday and Friday could be decided in the light of the progress of the meeting.

The Chair further suggests that the Data and Information Working Group, the Science Working Group and New Zealand as the host of the Interim Secretariat report to the meeting during the morning sessions on Monday 10 September.

If accepted by the meeting these suggestions should be regarded only as an initial guide for delegations and to be subject to any further decisions the meeting may wish to make at any time including arrangements for such meetings of the Data and Information Working Group and the Science Working Group as may be appropriate.
